DAY 1: ACCRA – KUMASI

Depart on a scenic drive from Accra, to the Ashanti Region. Embark on a city tour through Kumasi, to explore the legends of the famous Ashantis, whose legacies are still evident today. Your tour will include **Manhyia Palace Museum**, a regal history that dates back to 1700 is told with **relics** and **artifacts**. Enjoy a drive through the city with monuments dedicated to the memory of the great Ashanti people. End the day's tour at the **National Cultural Center (Anansekrom)** which features the **Prempeh II Jubilee Museum** and various studios of the brass makers, potters and batik makers. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kumasi.

DAY 2: AKWASIDAE

Breakfast is served at hotel. Participate in this special Akwasidae festival. The Akwasidae is a religious and cultural festival of the Asante's which is celebrated in grand style. On this day the Asante king comes out of the palace on a palanquin adorned in gold ornaments to receive the homage of his sub-chiefs and people. It is a very colorful ceremony that lasts the whole day and it is usually held at the Manhyia palace which is the **Asantehene's** residence. The celebration marks a period of stock taking and fervent assessment of events in the life of the Ashanti's. It serves as a period to propitiate the ancestors through whom the Ashanti Unity gains its grounds. Late afternoon, depart for the scenic drive back to Accra.

Welcome to this exciting tour to the Ashanti Region of Ghana! We are thrilled to have the opportunity to be your host for this special tour and will do all we can to ensure that it will be a memorable experience for you. We have drawn up a detailed itinerary (adjacent to this page) so you know exactly what each day entails. Here are some travel tips that you should be aware of before you travel:

THE TRIP

The total journey time from Accra to Kumasi takes approximately five (5) hours. The time for departure is 8.00 am. We ask all passengers to arrive at least fifteen (15) minutes before departure time. The pickup/drop-off point will be the front parking lot at the U.S Embassy, in Cantonments. The return portion of this trip, on the last day, will take approximately five (5) hours as well.

CLOTHING

You will be doing lots of walking, we recommend light weight casual clothing, comfortable shoes and a hat to protect you from the sun's rays. We also recommend you bring along insect repellent. If you would like to swim, bring along a bathing suit to enable you take advantage of the swimming pools.

FOOD

We suggest that you bring along snacks, soft drinks and water for the trip, you will spend some time on the road. You can bring along lunch, or purchase lunch when the vehicle makes brief stops on the journey. The menus at the hotel and restaurants offer local Ghanaian dishes and continental cuisine.

PHOTOGRAPHY
